When confronted, the former states that notwithstanding the earlier decisions, in <u>W.P No.3682-P/2021</u> titled "<u>M/s. Taj Re-Rolling & Steel Mills (Pvt) Ltd. Vs. Government of Pakistan and others</u>" on 30.06.2022 this controversy was placed before Division Bench of this Court and said Bench, while considering the decisions in the earlier petitions, referred the matter to Hon'ble the Chief Justice with request for constitution of a Larger Bench in the matter.
